SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME - YEAR B

21ST JULY 2024



Dear Parishioners, this weekend I would like to write to you about a significant upcoming change in the liturgical life of the Church in England and Wales. From the 1st Sunday of Advent, we will be having a new 'Lectionary', that is the book which contains the Scripture readings for Mass and the Sacraments. This is part of the process which began in 2011 with the changes to the Roman Missal. The translation of the readings will change from the Jerusalem text to the English Standard Version-Catholic Edition and the Abbey Psalter for the psalms. It is hoped the new Lectionary will be more faithful to the original languages and where appropriate more inclusive. I do know from my experience with the Roman Missal of 2011, that for some of us this will be a welcome change, for others not so, but let us pray that the new translations will be an opportunity of renewal, particularly around our prayer and reflection on the scriptures.


Mass Times
