Journey in Faith (RCIA) at Our Lady of the Wayside, Shirley.



The Journey in Faith programme recommences in September. This is for both those wishing to become Catholic as well as existing Catholics who wish to learn more about the riches of their faith. There are usually two sessions a month, each lasting from 7.00pm to 8.15pm, all on Tuesdays in St Aidan's Chapel. In each session, we have a mixture of prayer, scripture, teaching and discussion. This year, we are also adopting two patron saints for each session and will both learn about them and ask for their intercession. The Journey in Faith programme covers the four areas of Catholic life: prayer, morals, belief and sacraments – as laid out by the Catechism of the Catholic Church. It is orientated towards the baptism / reception of those wishing to become Catholic at the Easter Vigil in April 2025. Those who are already Catholic, not only have the opportunity to learn more about their faith but also can support others on their journey to become Catholic.
